In order to process your Consortium Agreement, you are required to:

1. Register at the “Host Institution” and abide by their academic and administrative regulations.
2. Request an official transcript from the “Host Institution” be sent to RHIT’s Registrar’s Office at the conclusion of the term covered by the Consortium Agreement.
3. Notify RHIT’s Financial Aid Office in the event of a change in your enrollment or withdrawal from any course. A change in your enrollment status may affect your financial aid eligibility.
4. Sign the Consortium Agreement. By signing this Agreement, you are granting RHIT’s Financial Aid Office the ability to release financial aid eligibility information to the “Host Institution”, if requested.

SECTION B – Home Institution Agreement (To be completed by RHIT Financial Aid Office)

Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology agrees to process the student financial aid application, determine eligibility and disburse funds in accordance with the Title IV regulations. Funds will only be disbursed to the student if an official Consortium Agreement has been completed by the “Host Institution” and returned to RHIT’s Financial Aid Office.
